As a blind person, life has its challenges – I can't play sports or drive a car. But it also has its benefits – I don't see skin color or what people look like on the outside.

Despite my limitations, being blind uniquely positions me to influence those around me. I learned to leverage my disability and my musical talent to connect with people at the heart level, and when I became a finalist on American Idol, millions of people were inspired to dream, innovate, and achieve.

Our focus is fourfold:


Creativity: We ignite artistic potential, helping blind musicians discover their unique musical voice.

Breaking Down Barriers for Aspiring Blind Musicians

By addressing the specific challenges faced by blind musicians, SongSight allows them to overcome barriers, embrace their musical dreams, and develop self-belief and vision for a better future.

Challenges faced by blind aspiring musicians

- Limited access to qualified mentors: Finding blind or sighted mentors with the expertise and understanding of visual impairment can be difficult.
- Isolation and lack of confidence: Blindness can lead to feelings of isolation, hindering the development of self-belief and a vision for a musical future.
- Unfamiliarity with accessible music resources:
 Navigating the world of music creation and recording can be challenging without specialized knowledge and tools.

Solution: Fostering Hope and Confidence Through SongSight

- Expert mentorship: Connecting attendees with renowned blind and sighted musicians provides invaluable guidance and role models.
- Collaborative environment: SongSight fosters a supportive community where blind musicians can connect, share experiences, and learn from each other.
- Accessible music resources: The retreat provides training on specialized tools and techniques that empower blind musicians to create and record music independently.

Results of the SongSight experience:

- Skill development: Attendees gain confidence and hone their musical abilities in a supportive and encouraging environment.
- Shift in perspective: SongSight empowers individuals to move from self-doubt to self-advocacy, viewing themselves as "musicians on a mission of hope."
- Inspiration: SongSight participants are equipped to inspire others through music, just like Scott MacIntyre, creating a ripple effect of hope and possibility within the blind community.

Programs & Initiatives







Music Mentoring Retreat: 3-day retreat, approx. 15 attendees

Blind musicians from across the US congregate in Scottsdale, Arizona for an intensive 3-day retreat with celebrity and industry mentors. Activities focus on personal and musical development, setting and achieving goals, self-advocacy, and community building.

Empowerment Opportunities: Post-retreat opportunities for select attendees

We give select attendees the opportunity to have their original songs professionally recorded and released to the world, to perform in public venues, and to receive free music lessons and equipment they couldn't otherwise afford.

Collaborative Satellite Workshop: Off-site 2-day workshop in partnership with blind-services organization

We bring the best elements of the SongSight retreat, in abbreviated form, to partner blind centers around the country to enhance programming for the blind in local communities and expose more individuals who are blind to the life-changing power of music.

Community Outreach:

We intentionally interact with a wide array of individuals who are blind and musically inclined across the country at various schools and blind centers through in-person events and Zoom workshops in order to raise awareness about SongSight and encourage the blind community at large in overcoming adversity and becoming productive members of society.
